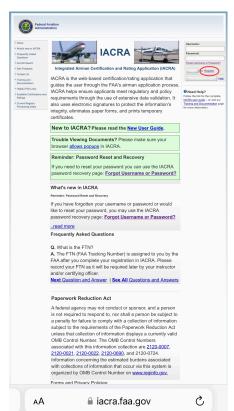
How to Get Started in Becoming a Student Pilot:

The first thing you will need to do is to get a <u>third class medical exam</u> as well as a <u>student pilot certificate.</u>

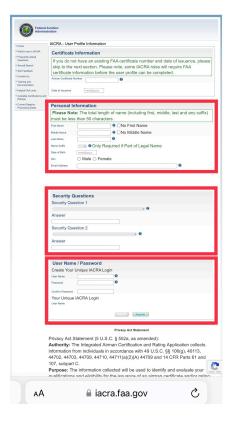

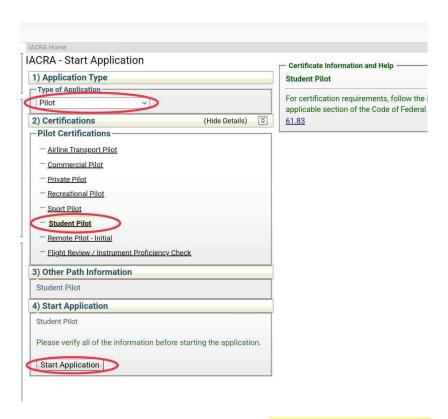






Once that is all complete, log in with the account information you've created and then it will take you to a terms of service page. Agree to the terms of service and it will take you to a page that says "start application."

Click on "start application" and then click or enter the following information (screenshot). Make sure you enter all information (name, DOB, place of birth, etc.) exactly as it appears on your government issued ID.



After it's all complete, they will give you an application number and a verification number, also known as the FTN. SAVE THIS INFORMATION! It is VERY important so that your flight instructor can use the number to complete the application.
